WHEN MISTAKES ARE NOT AN OPTION



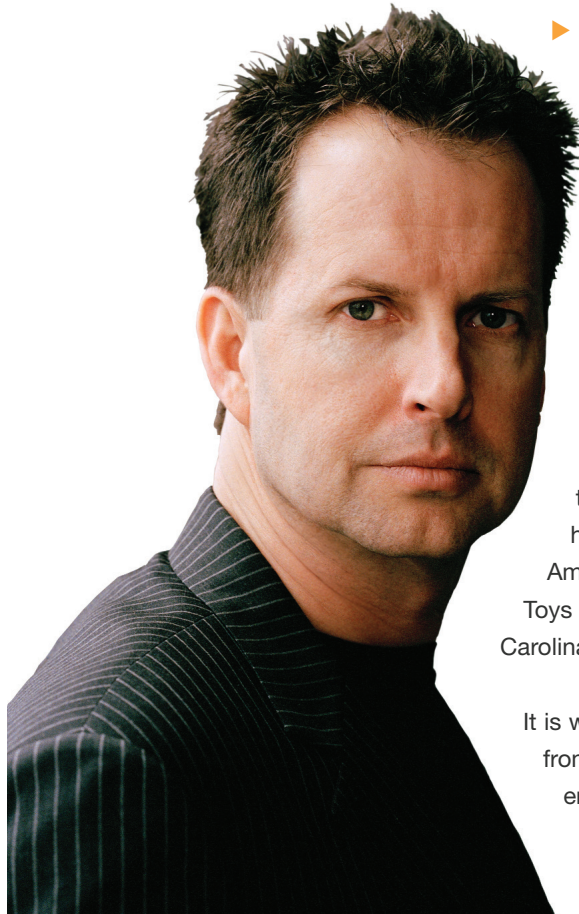

- ▶ Author of a Human Performance Tools handbook that takes complex error reduction strategies and distills them into simple tools to be used by everyone. Tim's handbook has been adapted worldwide by such companies as Entergy, Constellation Energy, Florida Power and Light, and General Electric.



Since 1995, Tim Autrey has put his expertise on human behavior and human error reduction to work within many of the world's largest organizations.
